Students completing coursework in the summer (August Graduates)

If your coursework will be completed in May Term or Summer 2022, you are a candidate for graduation in August 2022.

In order to participate ("walk") in the May commencement ceremonies:

You must be enrolled by April 15 in all remaining courses in May Term, Summer I or II. Contact the Registrar if you are **not able** to register for summer by this date.

Guests for Graduation

There is no limit on the number of guests to invite. Masks are not required for Baccalaureate or Commencement. Guests and graduates are welcome to wear masks if they choose to do so.

Ceremony Decorum

The McMurry University Commencement ceremony is the formal recognition by the University of your achievement as a student. Please remember that any unwarranted personal celebrations during the ceremony are inappropriate. Please ask your guests to celebrate with you following the ceremony in such a way that will not detract from the dignity of the day.

What is (or is not) worn with the Cap & Gown?

(for the Rehearsal / Baccalaureate / Commencement ceremony):

1. STOLES, HOODS, CORDS

- a) Only <u>ACADEMIC cords or honor hood provided by McMurry University</u> can be worn with the gown.
- b) NO individually selected stoles or decorations allowed on or with the gown.

 NO items associated with social clubs or any other non-academic organizations.
- c) The following approved academic cords and/or honor hood listed below can be worn:
 - Nursing candidates may wear the pin awarded at the Pinning Ceremony.
 - Students graduating with honors may wear the cord and/or hood awarded by McMurry.
 - Students who are members of Alpha Chi or nationally recognized departmental honor societies may wear the society cords. **

2. **CAPS**

- a) Writing, drawing, decoration is allowed on the top of the cap.
- b) The following is NOT allowed:
 - No attachments hanging from the cap or tassel.
 - Nothing of any kind deemed to be over the line of good taste.
- c) Failure to adhere to this policy will result in a new cap and the cost added to your charges with the University.

**Cords for Academic National Honor Societies

Members of nationally recognized academic honor societies are allowed to wear honor cords as part of their academic regalia.

Contact society sponsor to obtain the appropriate cord.

(The Registrar's office does not have cords for academic honor societies.)

Cords for Latin Academic Honors (Summa, Magna, Cum Laude)

Latin Honor Cords are provided for students graduating Summa Cum Laude, Magna Cum Laude, or Cum Laude, and will be available at the Registrar's office upon completing the Diploma Confirmation form previously emailed. Latin Honors require a GPA of 3.5 or higher and completion of a minimum 57 hours at McMurry University.

Dress: Cap and Gown and approved Honor Cords

- Men: Dark slacks, shoes and socks are recommended. Dress shirt with collar and a tie look really nice.
- Ladies: Dress or dark slacks are recommended. (Tip for the ladies: bobby pins for the caps help greatly, and shoes that do not slip are recommended.)
- Suggestion: The tassel falls off easily. It helps to wrap the cord around the button a couple of times.

Dress: Cap and Gown (as previously described)

Graduates have a tradition of processing across campus from the commencement rehearsal site to Baccalaureate. We will leave Kimbrell Arena at 5:00 p.m., followed by a processional to Baccalaureate.

Baccalaureate is an important part of the McMurry experience, and attendees should conduct themselves with proper decorum. Your parents and guests are encouraged to attend! The service begins at 5:30 and is approximately one hour in length. Note: Only graduates participate in the processional and sit in the graduate section.

Please make arrangements for children and other family/friends to sit elsewhere in the audience.
