Students may sign up on a first come/first serve basis. Please note the times below that you can come visit us to register. (If you will be gone due to extra-curricular events, reach out to Ailin Ortega to set up a sign-up time.)

Snooze You Lose – Fall Registration Opens Mon., April 3

Mon., April 3, registration begins for May, Summer, and Fall 2023. If you do not register for Fall 2023 classes by June 1, 2023, your housing reservation will be dropped.

This coming year, McMurry is utilizing Hunt and Martin Halls for incoming students, which means that there will be limited availability in Hunt and Martin Halls for returning students. You must reserve your space next week if you wish to live in one of these two buildings, as they will quickly fill up with incoming students.

In turn, we made changes to our requirements to offer more space to our returning students:

First *Juniors and Seniors are automatically exempt from living on campus. In order to live off-campus you must meet one of the following requirements:*

- Lived on campus 4 long semesters
- Completed a minimum of 60 McMurry credit hours.
- You are at least 21 years of age.
- You will be living with your parents or legal guardians within a 30-mile radius of the campus.
- Are married/getting married.

Second, *We will not be offering single rooms during registration.* If you believe you are eligible for a single space due to, for example, medical reasons, please contact residencelife@mcm.edu. We will, however, create a list of students wishing to have a single room should space become available. In order to be eligible for a single room, you must sign up for a space in either Hunt Hall, Martin Hall, or Gold Star Hall.

Lastly, *Once June 1st rolls around, Residence Life will not accept any more juniors or seniors onto campus living.* Again, it's important that upperclassmen see me during housing week to ensure you have a space on campus if desired.

If you wish to room with a specific friend or student, you will want to print out and bring a signed copy of the Roommate Agreement Form. Any student with an accepted signature on the form will not need to come to register in person for housing. The file is attached below! I will also be asking for your student ID to verify that you are a student!
