Requesting a roommate/suitemates

If you wish to room with a specific friend or student, make sure it is listed on all individual's applications on mcm.erezlife.com. For example, both individuals that want to room together should put each other's name down on the roommate request section. Roommate requests will close on July 1st for returning students.

April 2 – Registration Begins for Summer and Fall 2024

McMurry University will be utilizing Hunt and Martin Halls for incoming students, which means that space in Hunt and Martin is limited to returning students.

Off Campus Requirements

Juniors and Seniors are automatically exempt from living on campus; **HOWEVER, an off-campus application must still be submitted through mcm.erezlife.com.**

In order to live off-campus you must meet one of the following requirements:

- Lived on McMurry campus 4 long semesters or completed a minimum of 60 McMurry credit hours.
- Transfer student that has lived on a different campus for 4 long semesters
- You are at least 21 years of age before August 1st.
- You will be living with your parents or legal guardians within a 30-mile radius of campus.
- Are married/getting married within the 2024-2025 academic year.
- Have or will be having children/dependents.
- Have served or currently serve in the military.
- Medical exemption from a health professional.

In all instances, documentation will be requested to verify a student's off-campus request.

Single Rooms

Single room requests will NOT be offered during registration. If you believe you are eligible for a single space due to, for example, medical reasons, please contact residencelife@mcm.edu. We will, however, create a list of students wishing to have a single room should space become available. In order to be eligible for a single room, you must sign up for a space in either Hunt Hall, Martin Hall, or Gold Star Hall, and you will be charged the rate for a single room.
