



## Summer Housing 2024 Policies and Procedures

To be eligible for summer 2024 housing, you must meet one of the following requirements:

- Be registered for the corresponding summer term classes
- Register/stay registered throughout the summer for fall 2024 classes
- Be approved to work on campus for the corresponding summer term

### Timeline:

Summer applications are open April 2nd – May 3rd

- Applications are completed on your [mcm.erezlife.com](https://mcm.erezlife.com) account for each term needed.
- Applications submitted after May 3rd are not guaranteed and will be considered based on summer housing availability

### Moves to be aware of:

Move #1 –

You will move from your current spring housing assignment to the room designated by housing staff for the summer term(s) no later than the Monday after graduation.

Move #2 –

You will move from your summer housing assignment at the earliest date given by housing staff to your fall 2024 housing assignment.

### Billing:

The charges for each summer term applicable will be billed to your student account. The student billing office will be able to help with any questions or if you need to set up a payment plan with them. The office of residence life can assist with getting you in touch with our billing office if needed.
