PRE-ARRIVAL CHECKLIST

Ensure a smooth move-in by completing these essential tasks before arriving on campus:

- Complete the housing application
check your email for the link
- Submit medical records to the nurse

- Register full time for classes

Arrival and Check-in:

1. Turn onto Sentinel Drive (the first turn-in/parking lot off the corner of Sayles Blvd and South 14th St).
2. Drive through the parking lot to the Check-In Tent on the right side, next to the Centennial Garden.
3. REMAIN IN YOUR VEHICLE during the check-in process. Roll your passenger window down, and staff will check you in, give you your ID, and verify all move-in requirements have been met.
4. If all requirements are met, skip to step 7.

Address Outstanding Requirements:

5. If any requirements are outstanding, loop back to park your vehicle on the left side of the parking lot facing Radford (the large, church-like building). Staff will meet you at your car and guide you to the appropriate office to resolve any issues.
6. Once all move-in requirements are met, return to your vehicle and re-enter the check-in line on the right side of the parking lot to complete check-in, receive your ID, and proceed to Move-In.

Procedure:

7. Drive down Sentinel Drive to your residence hall. Pause on the drive adjacent to your residence hall for unloading. Do not enter the parking lots.
 - Martin Residence Hall is the first building on the right.
 - Hunt Residence Hall is the second building on the right.
 - Gold Star Residence Hall is on the left side of Sentinel Drive, across from Hunt.
8. **REMAIN IN YOUR VEHICLE** as Orientation Leaders and staff unload your car and take items to your student's room.
 - Students may accompany their belongings to their residence hall while at least one parent or guest moves on to park.
 - If a student is unaccompanied, Orientation Leaders and staff will handle the unloading and transport of belongings while the student parks.

Parking:

9. Proceed down Sentinel Drive to Ross Avenue and park your car in one of the designated parking lots across the street. Refrain from parking on Ross Avenue itself.
 - You may walk back to the residence halls from the parking lot to help your student set up their room.
 - Golf carts will be available for transporting people with mobility issues from the parking lots to the residence halls.
