

McMurry University General Education and Cisco College Associate of Arts Degree Core Curriculum Articulation

Students who earn the *Associate of Arts Degree* at Cisco College <u>before</u> transferring to McMurry University will have completed McMurry's General Education requirements except for:

- 3 semester hours of course options listed in the general education Christian Tradition area.
- Any required general education course in which a grade below "C" was earned at Cisco.

This agreement will take effect beginning with the Fall 2015 semester.

Please note that the following conditions apply:

- All requirements for admission to McMurry must be met as outlined in the catalog.
- Some majors or degrees may require additional prerequisites not met by a junior or community college core curriculum.
- A grade of 'C' or higher is required for any course transferred to McMurry. Transfer grades are not calculated in the McMurry GPA.
- Courses not accepted for transfer include, but are not limited to, vocational, technical, or Workforce Education Credit (WECM), developmental, or courses taken for pass/fail.
- No course taken at a junior or community college will be transferred as advanced credit hours.
- A maximum of 66 semester hours may be transferred from a junior or community college to McMurry.
